Weapons of Mass Destruction Found! Iraqi War Justified: WMDs Discovered in Underground Cache

BAGHDAD, IRAQ – Early Tuesday morning, US forces uncovered an expansive chemical weapons cache hidden thousands of feet beneath the Iraqi desert.

After more than a year of searching, it was thought by many that such weapons never existed. The discovery dispelled widespread accusations that the Bush administration led the United States to war on a lie.

President Bush announced the news in a television address.

"My fellow Americans, France was wrong, and I was right," began Bush. "We entered this war under the pretense of DubyaMDs.

Over the past year, it's been a difficult search. Some dishonest hooligans wanted to make a liar out of me. Earlier today, we proved them wrong. We found what we were looking for all along."

The extensive underground Iraqi weapons cache contained a highly volatile chemical called petroleum. The viscous liquid and its fumes combust when exposed to open flame.

Lubbock an Underwater City by 2010

LUBBOCK, TX - Instead of looming draught, meteorologists forecast that Lubbock could be an underwater metropolis in less than six years.

Lubbock city council and other high-ranking officials held a two hour closed-door conference in a local McDonald's play area to discuss the potential catastrophe.

"If it keeps raining like it did last week, we're all screwed", Lubbock mayor Marc McDougal said after the conference. "Lubbock was not made to handle this much stuff falling from the sky. Damn you La Nino!"

When the city was designed years ago, officials scoffed at building a sensible underground drain-

age system. They estimated that a small network of playa lakes would accommodate the insignificant rainfalls Lubbock generally receives.

Recent weeks of steady rainfalls have pushed Lubbock's playa lakes beyond their capacity.

Urinals in Architecture Building Unfit for Use

Splash-back Rating of 2.7 Highest in Urinal Industry

TEXAS TECH UNIVERSITY - The Lubbock-based Hannover Bathroom Products Corporation is facing a serious dilemma in the form of its highly inefficient and irregularly shaped urinals installed in the Texas Tech Architecture Building.

"These are, hands-down, a complete failure of modern industrial design," stated architecture student Rick Peterson. "Everything about them seems to have been a design compromise, and they're simply much too impractical for use by a man of average height. That and the rate of splash-back is absolutely terrifying." Peterson mentioned that he no longer even uses the Architecture bathrooms, electing instead to walk across a field to the Business Administration building. When asked why he

would go to such extreme measures in order to secure a place to relieve himself, he replied "Too many times have I been embarrassed by a moisture-stippled khaki pant leg!"

Carl Hannover, the CEO of Hannover Bathroom Products, defended his design by issuing a press release stating that "the fault lies with the original building contractors, who mistakenly placed each urinal nearly two feet higher than their intended installation level. Our urinal design solutions cannot be held accountable for the student and faculty complaints." Hannover declined to comment on exactly what installation height his corporation's urinals were designed with, stating only that "the original building contractors botched our company's installation procedures. Their work should be

faulted, not the work of our professional design team."

Against Hannover's requests, a team of researchers from the Bathroom Products Regulations Committee discovered alarming statistics in the Hannover urinals in the form of splash-back ratings. These ratings, which measure the amount of dispersed waste droplets during urination, are the most serious measure of urinal designs in the area of sanitation control. Their research showed that the Hannover design generated a splash-back rating of 2.7, nearly a point higher than the next highest rating of 1.8, generated by the Conn Flush Saver 6000, a popular urinal for enclosed-stadium contracts. "This is a serious problem for the Hannover Corporation that must be remedied immediately," stated an

anonymous Bathroom Products Regulations Committee member. The B.P.R. Committee failed to provide information as to whether or not the improper installed urinal height influenced the dangerously high splash-back rating.

from a devious terrorist dictator who wanted nothing more than to destruct the liberties of America in a ball of petroleum explosion hell-fire terror."

Some evidence suggests that the United States' preemptive attack thwarted such a plot only minutes before it was to be carried out.

A large transport ship intercepted as it departed the Iraqi port city of Umm Qasr carried 21 million gallons of the chemical weapon. According to documents found onboard, its intended target destination was Houston, TX.

CIA officials speculated that such a massive quantity of petroleum contains enough chemical energy to power a large city for weeks. If detonated in an American port, the resulting explosion would inflict catastrophic damage similar to that of the 9-11 attacks.

Officials estimate that Iraq may have accumulated more than a billion gallons of the chemical weapon in pre-existing subterranean reservoirs.

In a gesture of goodwill, the Halliburton Corporation volunteered its services, free of charge, in the secure removal and disposal of Iraq's petroleum.

Vice President Dick Cheney, former CEO of Halliburton, presented the gracious offer to the President in person.

"It's a daunting logistics task," said Cheney. "Halliburton is willing to take a huge financial loss to prove to the American people how patriotic they are. President Bush and I have decided to give the company a substantial tax write-off to reward Halliburton's efforts in fighting international terrorism."

The petroleum caches in Iraq are so large, that Halliburton projects the disposal process to last for several decades.

A considerable portion of

Iraqi infrastructure is devoted to the weaponization and distribution of the dangerous substance. Large above-ground processing facilities boost the chemical's octane content to increase its explosive potency. US officials have dubbed this synthetically enriched petroleum "weapons grade petrol."

Illegal trade of "weapons grade petrol" accounted for an alarming 79% of the Arab nation's economy.

US troops also discovered several international petroleum pipelines originating in Iraq. The lines have implicated Syria and Russia in a chemical weapons trade ring.

In a proposal to preemptively disarm these nations of their purchased chemical weapons, Colin Powell presented the incriminating evidence to the United Nations Security Council.

"Iraq has been selling chemical weapons en masse to Syria and Russia for the better part of a century," Powell told skeptical UN

representatives. "Petrol proliferation must be put to an end! We should strike now, and confiscate their weapons before it's too late."

Jon Pier Lamar, UN delegate of France, interjected that the transactions between Iraq and Russia were sanctioned under the UN sponsored "weapons for food" program. The humanitarian program permitted Iraq to trade small amounts of chemical weapons in order to feed its starving citizens.

RIAA Arrests Student in Dorm

TEXAS TECH UNIVERSITY - The Recording Industry Association of America (RIAA) is getting tough on music pirates.
